



## **QUESTION & ANSWER**

### TELL US A BIT About yourself

#### I'm Terri (Sheppard) Rogers. I was born and raised here in the community, on the southside of Harbour Grace. I'm a registered massage therapist and have a reputation among clients for deep tissue massage. I operate my clinic out of my home on 21 Glover Rd, Harbour Grace.

### WHY HARBOUR GRACE?

Well, funnily enough, I started in Carbonear. I ran a clinic for around two years there, operating out of the former Eden Studio on Powell Drive. However, that was only temporary: it was just a place to operate while getting things prepared for my home clinic. Honestly, the main reason for 'Why Harbour Grace?' is that I'm from here and I want to be here; I want my two boys to grow up here. It just made sense. The home clinic gives me some flexibility, too, but the main reason is that Harbour Grace is home. I love it here.

# WHAT ARE SOME OF THE CHALLENGES OPERATING IN HARBOUR GRACE?

We definitely **need to see the benefit of supporting local**, of supporting the people here. That's how we grow and move ahead; **that's a part of building community.** There's the traffic issue, too. Sometimes people don't know I'm here, because I'm off the beaten track on Glover Road. Overall, we need to improve infrastructure, because **better infrastructure will bring more investment.** But we'll get there, I think. I'm positive.



### HOW DID COVID-19 AFFECT OPERATIONS?



It was definitely a struggle. I mean, when things shutdown in March 2020, I couldn't operate until June 2020. And then there was the situation in February 2021. You're only getting revenue when people come in the door, and if people have to stay home, then you're not getting that revenue. People still have their concerns going out and about, coming for their sessions, and that's totally understandable. Unfortunately, I think we'll be dealing with this pandemic for a while yet.



### WHAT GETS YOU EXCITED About your business? What inspires you?

I have a real connection to my work. Originally, it goes back to when I was injured in an accident. My registered massage therapist helped me so much in my recovery and management of that injury. I was in school at the time, unsure about what I wanted to do, and I really wanted to help people. I figured massage therapy would be a great opportunity to do just that. Again, I could see the real benefit of the work, because massage therapy helped me so much. So, I can really put myself in my clients' shoes and that really inspires my work and my business.

### **PLANS FOR THE FUTURE?**

Just to grow my base of clients. I have a good group of regular clients, but I'm always looking for more people. I'm the sole employee, and I realistically don't see that changing, but there's lots of opportunity to grow here in the community.
