

Maintenance of Rights of Way Policy

- Ownership of roads to be maintained by Council must be vested (owned) by the Town.
- Maintenance of roads to be limited to those traditionally serviced.
- Extension of maintenance of Town owned roads may be approved by Council, provided it is necessary for public use and does not compromise public safety.
- Private roads may be taken over by Council, without compensation, provided the road has been brought up to a standard satisfactory to Council and is necessary for public use.
- Residents must not block vehicular access to municipal rights of way. Any vehicles blocking access will be towed at the owner's expense.
