Recycling will begin on **May 9th, 2016** and will be picked up **bi-weekly**. Pick up will be on the same day as your garbage pick up, **Monday or Thursday**. Items must be separated as described below and must be in large **SEE-THROUGH BLUE** bags. This is a new program for our Town and a learning process for us all but if we work together, we can make this a success for our residents and future generations.

Separate bag for CONTAINERS

Aluminum Trays

e.g. pie plates, baking trays

Aluminum Cans

Aluminum Cans

e.g. pop cans, beer cans & more

Milk & Juice Cartons

Plastic Trays & Tubs

e.g. butter & sour cream tubs, vegetable & fruit trays, plastic berry containers

Plastic Food Containers

e.g. ketchup, mustard, yogurt & more

Plastic Cleaning Product Containers

e.g. bleach, liquid laundry detergent, all-purpose cleaner, spray bottles, windshield wash bottles & more

Plastic Toiletries Containers

e.g. shampoo, liquid soap, mouthwash, contact lens solution, body wash & more

Plastic Drink Bottles

e.g. water, pop, liquor & more

Steel (Tin) Cans

e.g. soup cans, bean cans, tuna cans, coffee cans & more

Tetra Pak Containers

e.g. juice boxes, soup containers & more

Separate bag for PAPER

Newspaper, Flyers & Junk Mail

Magazines, Catalogues & Phone Books

Writing & Computer Paper

e.g. lined, white, coloured

Envelopes

e.g. paper & plastic window envelopes, but not bubble or insulated envelopes

Books

Remove hard covers

Boxboard

e.g. cereal, cracker, detergent boxes, frozen food boxes & more

Egg Cartons

Just the cardboard kind, not the Styrofoam kind

Take Out Drink Trays

Empty Paper Towel & Toilet Paper Rolls

Just the empty cardboard rolls, not the toilet paper or paper towels themselves

Corrugated Cardboard

Must be in a tied-up blue bag or bundled to no more than 2ft x 2ft x 1ft

Do NOT put in curbside recycling

Glass

Glass beverage containers can be brought to Green Depots

Plastic Bags or Film

e.g. shopping bags, chip bags, bread bags, saran wrap, wax paper & more

Styrofoam

e.g. plates, food trays, packaging & more

Needles & Other Sharp Items

e.g. syringes, sewing needles, nails or screws & more

Kitty Litter

Diapers

Drink/Coffee Cups

Aerosol Cans

Empty Paint Cans

Empty paint cans can go in your garbage. Left over paint in cans should be brought to the HHW Depot.

Gift Wrap

e.g. wrapping paper, gift bags, tissue paper & greeting cards

Napkins, Tissues, Toilet Paper or Paper Towels

Used or unused, these items are not recyclable

Household Metals

e.g. pots & pans, utensils & more

Large Plastics

e.g. dish racks, stepping stools, laundry

Reminders:

- ◆ Use only see-through blue bags or clear bags
- ◆ Rinse Food Containers
- ◆ Remove Caps & Lids, they are not recyclable
- ◆ Remove straws from juice boxes
- ◆ Bag paper recyclables separate from containers

- ◆ Cardboard must be bagged or tied in a bundle
- ◆ Pick up is bi-weekly
- ◆ Milk cartons are recyclable, be sure to put them in your "containers" bag and not the "paper" bag
- ◆ Flyers, catalogues & junk mail are recyclable but the plastic bags that they come in are not.
