 December 2, 2025, for site improvements. The facility will reopen on
 December 2 at 12 p.m. (noon).
- The Eastern Regional Service Board (ERSB) would like to remind users that the grace period for access card use will end on January 2, 2026. Starting on this date, anybody wishing to use a Waste Recovery Facility must present a valid ERSB Access Card to drop off waste materials. If you have not received your access card, please submit your application as soon as possible to ensure you receive your card before the grace period ends. ERSB requires approximately 4–6 weeks to process an application. Late applications will be accepted after the deadline and processed as usual.
